Narrator: It's the biggest night of the year in Hollywood as Oscar steps into the spotlight for the twenty-ninth time. And at the Pantages Theater just about everybody who's anybody in the film world is on hand for the Annual Academy Awards presentation ceremony. Among them, Robert Stack, nominated as Best Supporting Actor for his role in *Written on the Wind*. A special ovation greets Janet Gaynor, who in 1929 was the first to receive the award as Best Actress.

Anthony Quinn this year won his second Oscar for his role in *Lust for Life*. Popular youngster Tim Hovey was among the onlookers, as was starlet Vikki Dougan who earlier made an impression with her part in *The Great Man* and made quite an impression tonight. The theater is jammed with a dazzling array of personalities as the Oscars, Hollywood's highest honor, are presented.

Jack Lemmon presents the award to Best Supporting Actress Dorothy Malone for her appearance in U.I.'s *Written on the Wind*, which was nominated in three categories. Yul Brynner receives the accolade of Best Actor of the Year from Anna Magnani for *The King and I*. Ernest Borgnine bestows the award for the Best Actress of the Year won by Ingrid Bergman, accepted on her behalf by Cary Grant. For the Best Picture, *Around the World in 80 Days*, producer Mike Todd receives his Oscar from Janet Gaynor. Another thrilling Academy Award evening in which Hollywood honors its own.
